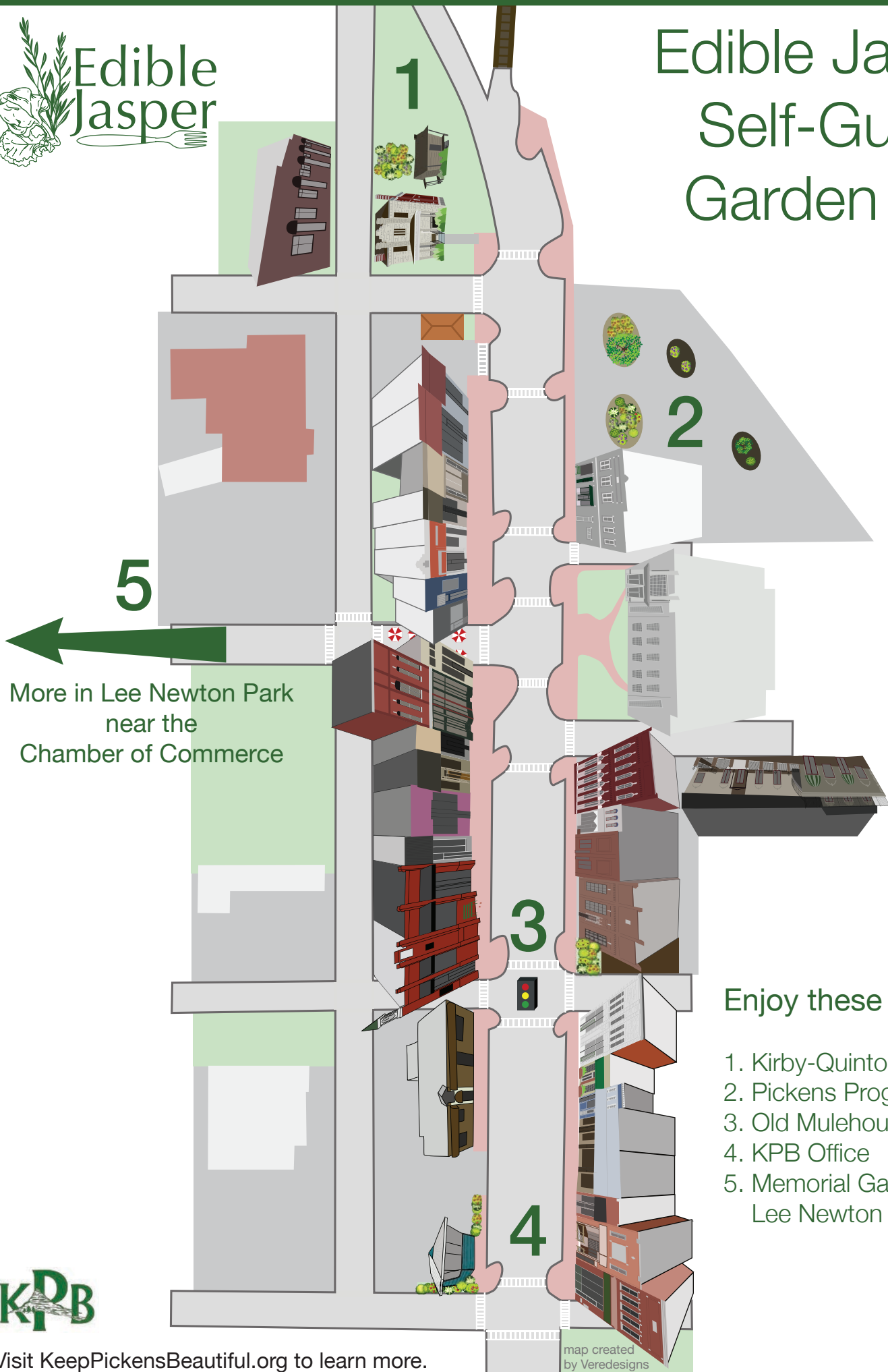

Working Together To Edibly Landscape Jasper

Edible Jasper is a project that was started in 2011 by a small group of residents who wanted to promote sustainable and beneficial landscaping. The *Pickens County Progress* invited them to begin in their parking lot. Those original gardens still grow around the front two light posts at the *Progress* building; KPBB has improved them and is growing more gardens around the other lights in the parking lot. Plants include a variety of herbs, figs, blueberries, and strawberries.

During the summer and fall of 2021, KPBB installed a garden behind the Historic Kirby-Quinton Cabin. It contains a wide range of herbs including thyme varieties, rosemary, lavender, sage, oregano, blueberries, strawberries, garlic, onions, elderberry, and more! As the garden progresses, we will incorporate more period-specific plants.

The Edible Jasper team has also improved the gardens around our office at the south end of Main Street and is growing a community greenspace adjacent to our building under the arbors.

We continue to add more gardens - we recently added Edible Jasper plants to our Memorial Garden in Lee Newton Park near the Chamber of Commerce. And we have plans for more garden adventures throughout the community. Let us know if we can help foodscope your space!
