Meet the Historians - July 31 at 6:00 - 8:00 at the Talking Rock Schoolhouse

The Talking Rock Schoolhouse was originally a two-story frame schoolhouse constructed in Ludville in 1877 as one of the first schools in Pickens County. With the coming of the railroad through the present village of Talking Rock, the economic center of the county moved east. The Ludville School was moved to Talking Rock about 1883 where it served as a schoolhouse until 1933. Today it is a delightful museum interpreting early schools.
